
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2522 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2522 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2522 would permit vehicles engaged in highway construction and maintenance operations to display flashing, rotating, or oscillating amber, green, or white lights at all times in a road construction zone either by themselves or in a combination of two or three lights. Stationary vehicles engaged in highway construction and maintenance operations may display flashing, rotating, or oscillating white and blue lights in a road construction zone if the lights are used between sunset and sunrise and workers are present in the construction zone. The bill would take effect upon its publication in the statute book.

The Department of Transportation and the Highway Patrol indicate enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect.
