
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2555 by Representative Waymaster

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2555 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2555 would require that any grant applications for funding through the federal Rural Health Transformation Program be reviewed by the Kansas Rural Health Innovation Alliance and then presented to the State Finance Council at a meeting of the Council. The bill would also require information on expenditures through the program be presented at a State Finance Council meeting. Any information provided to the State Finance Council would also be required to be presented and provided to the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Ways and Means during the regular Legislative session and to the Legislative Budget Committee when the Legislature is not in regular session. The bill would require the Governor to designate who would present and provide the information as required. The bill would take effect upon publication in the *Kansas Register*.

According to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment, any additional workload required as a result of the enactment of HB 2555 would be handled within existing resources. The Governor's Office reports that the bill would not have a fiscal effect on agency operations.
