
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2581 by House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2581 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2581 would authorize an animal shelter to move animals needing certain treatment or care not provided by the shelter to a foster home. The bill would establish a holding period and require the shelter to post a photograph on its website of an animal at a location other than the shelter.

The Kansas Department of Agriculture indicates that the enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect.
