
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2584 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2584 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2584 would allow the option to list a mailing address on driver licenses if requested by the licensee. Current law only allows the address of the licensee's principal residence to be used. The bill would also amend requirements for the type of photograph placed on licenses.

According to the Kansas Department of Revenue, enactment of HB 2584 would not result in a fiscal effect on agency operations. The Kansas Highway Patrol notes that there would likely be an operational impact on the agency, but no fiscal effect is anticipated. The Kansas Association of Counties reports that enactment of the bill could impact counties that still handle driver's licenses in their motor vehicle operations if more individuals request their mailing address rather than home address, but a total fiscal effect cannot be estimated.
