
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2603 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and
Economic Development

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2603 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2603 would define “battery-charged security fence” and include a list of several descriptors that would have to be met for a fence to meet the definition. The bill would prohibit municipalities from adopting or enforcing certain ordinances, resolutions, codes, standards, or regulations related to fences, as described in the bill.

According to the League of Kansas Municipalities, enactment of HB 2603 would not have a fiscal effect for cities.
