
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2616 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2616 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2616 would amend the law governing the Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Advisory Committee. The bill would add a provision allowing a Kansas law enforcement agency to request, through the advisory committee, that the Superintendent of the Highway Patrol and the Director of the Kansas Bureau of Investigation make available temporary personnel and other assistance in support of funeral services honoring law enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty in the service of the state.

The Kansas Bureau of Investigation and the Highway Patrol indicate that enactment of HB 2616 would have no fiscal effect on the operations of the respective agencies.
