
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2627 by House Committee on Veterans and Military

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2627 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Currently, a private employer could adopt employment policies to give preference to hire veterans. HB 2627 would expand the preference to include service members and eligible spouses. A service member would have to submit certification of current military membership in good standing and be stationed in Kansas. An eligible spouse would submit proof of marriage, certification signed by the unit commander of the spouse's military membership stationed in Kansas, and proof of residency in Kansas.

The Adjutant General's Department and the Office of Veterans Services both state that the bill would not have a fiscal effect.
