SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2669 by House Committee on Local Government


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2669 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2669 would prohibit owner associations from limiting or prohibiting the installation of rooftop solar energy conversion systems for any unit owned by a unit owner. The bill would authorize owner associations to adopt reasonable rules regarding the placement of rooftop solar energy conversion systems that would not prevent the installation of the system, impair the functioning of the system, restrict the use of the system, or adversely affect the cost or efficiency of the system. The bill would not apply to a common interest community.

The Kansas Corporation Commission indicates that the enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on its operations.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates that the enactment of the bill could have a fiscal effect on counties for potentially increased litigation due to disputes. However, a precise estimate cannot be determined. The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates that the enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on cities.
