
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2670 by Representative Roeser, et al.

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2670 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2670 would prohibit certain video streaming services from transmitting commercial advertisements with audio louder than the main video streaming content beginning July 1, 2026. The bill would be consistent with regulations adopted by the Federal Communications Commission for television broadcasting stations, cable operators, and other multichannel video programming distributors.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates that the enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on counties. Potential court costs could increase due to disputes; however, a precise estimate cannot be determined. The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates that the enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on cities.
