
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2716 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2716 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2716 would permit a person with a permanent disability to be issued one special license plate for each vehicle owned as long as the vehicle is owned and operated by such person. The bill would make technical amendments and limit a person responsible for the transportation of a person with a disability to one special license plate.

The Kansas Department of Revenue (KDOR) estimates that the enactment of the bill would increase expenditures by \$9,700 from the State General Fund in FY 2027 for administrative costs related to vehicle service for updating design documents, forms, policy and procedure documents, and retraining KDOR and county staff for \$1,400 (40 hours x \$35), user acceptance testing system changes for \$2,800 (80 hours x \$35), and costs related to vehicle development for \$5,500 (80 hours x \$50 = \$4,000 plus 60 hours x \$25 = \$1,500). Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2716 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.
