SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2724 by House Committee on Judiciary


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2724 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2724 would allow a poverty affidavit to be filed in lieu of municipal court expungement fees and in lieu of docket fees that must accompany petitions for expungement.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates enactment of the bill could increase expenditures of the Judicial Branch. The bill could require district court clerk staff to devote additional time to the cases outlined in the bill. The bill could also result in a decrease in docket fee revenue from the waiving of fees, which would have been deposited into the State General Fund. However, a precise fiscal effect cannot be estimated. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2724 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.

The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on cities.
