
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2740 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2740 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2740 would adopt the compounding standards established by United States Pharmacopeia for sterile, nonsterile, and radiopharmaceutical and would become part of the state's Pharmacy Act. Under current law, the Board of Pharmacy is required to adopt rules and regulations governing proper compounding practices and distribution of compounded drugs by pharmacists and pharmacies. The bill would remove the requirement for the Board to adopt rules and regulations; however, the Board could adopt rules and regulations if it would choose. Also, the bill would allow the Board to establish exemptions or waivers from the compounding standards. The bill would take effect and be in force on and after July 1, 2027.

The Board of Pharmacy states any fiscal effect resulting from the bill's enactment would be absorbed within existing resources.
