SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2748 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2748 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, a protective order or approved consent agreement must remain in effect until modified or dismissed by the court for a period of not less than one year and not more than two years. HB 2748 would increase the length of time from a period of not less than one year and not more than five years.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates enactment of the bill would have a negligible fiscal effect that could be absorbed within existing resources. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2748 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.
