
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2758 by House Committee on Veterans and Military

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2758 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2758 would require the Capitol Preservation Committee to approve plans to place a permanent registry kiosk within the state capitol of Kansas military forces killed in action or who died of wounds incurred during active duty. The bill would authorize the Secretary of Administration to receive private funds to finance the creation and construction of the registry kiosk. The bill would establish the Kansas Military Forces Registry Kiosk Fund and would prohibit public funds from being expended for the project.

The Department of Administration states enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on the agency. Legislative Administrative Services indicates enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect. Meetings of the Capitol Preservation Committee would have to be approved by the Legislative Coordinating Council, and expenditures associated with the meeting would be absorbed within existing resources. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2758 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.
