
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2770 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2770 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2770 would expand the investment options allowed for the Health Care Stabilization Fund. Under current law, there is a defined list of allowable investment instruments. The bill would add other instruments that are authorized for insurance companies to invest in. The bill would take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.

The Health Care Stabilization Fund (HCSF) states that enactment of HB 2770 would have no fiscal impact on HCSF administration expenses. The agency indicates that the fiscal impact of future investments is unknown; however, investment changes have the potential to increase or decrease the overall portfolio.
