
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 251 by Senate Committee on Public Health and Welfare

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 251 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 251 would require the Kansas Department of Health and Environment to submit an annual report to the Legislature beginning April 1, 2026, on the Kansas Newborn Screening Program. The bill would detail the requirements of the report.

KDHE reports that costs related to the report required by SB 251 could be handled within existing resources.
