SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 308 by Senator Corson

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 308 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 308 would prohibit an individual from being hired as a lobbyist to represent anyone before any state agency if such individual has been a member of the Legislature at any time during the immediately preceding four years. The bill would also make several technical amendments to current statute.

The Kansas Public Disclosure Commission indicates enactment of the bill would have a minimal fiscal effect that could be absorbed within existing resources. The Commission estimates that approximately five individuals would no longer register with the Commission, resulting in a loss of revenue to the agency of approximately \$1,350 annually, and that lobbyist handbooks would have to be reprinted at a one-time cost to the agency of approximately \$2,700 in FY 2027. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 308 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.
