SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 327 by Robert G. Bethel Joint Committee on Home and Community Based Services and KanCare Oversight

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 327 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 327 would remove the requirement that the Joint Committee must meet when the Legislature is in regular session. The Joint Committee would still be required to meet at least once in January and once in April but would not be required to meet while the Legislature is in session.

The Legislative Coordinating Council estimated that enactment of SB 327 could increase expenditures for the Legislature by \$22,065 in FY 2027 and \$24,000 in FY 2028, all from the State General Fund. These expenditures would continue in the out-years. This estimate includes salaries, subsistence, mileage, and other costs associated with meeting twice outside of session. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 327 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.
