
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 331 by Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Insurance

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 331 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 331 would repeal KSA 52-717, which does not allow any provision of law to be construed to prevent banks from paying checks, drafts, or other bills of exchange on Saturday afternoon, or on any legal holiday, provided such payments would be legal if made at other times.

The Office of the State Bank Commissioner, the Department of Credit Unions, the State Treasurer, the Pooled Money Investment Board, and the Department of Revenue indicate SB 331 would not have a fiscal effect on the agencies' operations. The Kansas Association of Counties and the League of Kansas Municipalities both indicate that SB 331 would not have fiscal effect.
