
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 338 by Senate Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 338 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 338 would include a “home school” into the statutory definition of a “private elementary or secondary school.” The bill would define a “home school” as a nonaccredited nonpublic school where a parent, or similar person, directs the private instruction of the parent’s child.

According to the Department of Education, the enactment of SB 338 would have no fiscal effect on state aid to school districts or administrative costs for the agency. The Kansas Association of School Boards indicates that the enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on schools.
