
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 339 by Senate Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 339 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 339 would require school districts to provide at least 30 minutes of daily recess time for students in kindergarten through grade five for each school day that exceeds five hours in duration. In addition, the bill would state that school districts should provide at least 60 minutes of recess each school day.

The Department of Education reports that the enactment of SB 339 would have no fiscal effect on state aid to school districts or on the agency's administrative costs. The Kansas Association of School Boards indicates that the enactment of the bill would require school districts to pay for staff to supervise the increased recess time. However, a fiscal effect cannot be estimated.
