
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 344 by Senate Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 344 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 344 would authorize an animal shelter to move animals needing certain treatment or care not provided by the shelter to a foster home. The bill would establish a holding period and require the shelter to post a photograph on its website of an animal at a location other than the shelter.

The Kansas Department of Agriculture indicates that the enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on its operations. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 344 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.
