SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 349 by Senate Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 349 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 349 would require the Kansas State High School Activities Association to use a multiplier factor to adjust a private school's student attendance for classification of a school for activities. The factors for adjustment would include: (1) if a school has won at least five but not more than nine state championships; and (2) if a school has won 10 or more state championships. The bill would also outline a geographic population multiplier factor, as well as a socio-economic population multiplier factor. The bill's provisions would expire on June 30, 2031.

The Department of Education and the Kansas Association of School Boards indicate that the enactment of SB 349 would have no fiscal effect.
