SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 366 by Senate Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 366 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 366 would designate Bridge Number 0087-B0854 located on I-135 in Sedgwick County as the Don Snyder Memorial Bridge. The bill would require the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) to place signs to indicate the designation.

KDOT estimates that it would cost \$3,460 to manufacture and install one sign for the bridge designated in the bill. However, current law requires that sufficient gifts and donations be received by KDOT prior to installing the sign to reimburse the agency for the initial cost, plus an additional 50.0 percent of the initial cost to defray future sign maintenance. Altogether, \$5,190 would be needed from donations to install the sign. KDOT indicates implementation of the bill would require an increase of \$5,190 to the expenditure limitation for the agency operations account in FY 2027. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 366 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.
