
**SUBJECT:    Fiscal Note for SB 427 by Senate Committee on Judiciary**

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 427 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 427 would change current law regarding the Senate Committee on Confirmation Oversight. The bill would clarify that the Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson of this committee would have access to review tax information, as well as Kansas Bureau of Investigation (KBI) background checks, on individuals appointed to an office who are also subject to Senate confirmation.

Legislative Administrative Services and the KBI, indicate the enactment of SB 427 would have no fiscal effect. Although the Department of Revenue has not formally responded to the Division of the Budget's fiscal note request, the Division estimates that the enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on the Department.
