SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 451 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 451 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 451 would require treasurers for candidates for state office to file campaign finance reports that show in detail products and services provided by an advertising agency, public relations firm, or political consultant, including the date and purpose of each such expenditure.

The Secretary of State and the Public Disclosure Commission indicate enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect.
