
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 473 by Senate Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 473 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 473 would specify that on and after the effective date of the bill, Audubon of Kansas may convey certain real estate described in the bill. No conveyance of real estate would be made by Audubon of Kansas until the deeds and conveyances have been reviewed and approved by the State Historical Society. The bill would take effect upon its publication in the *Kansas Register*.

The State Historical Society indicates that the enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
