SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 510 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 510 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 510 would require interest earnings attributable to the balance of the Parks Fee Fund under the Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks to be transferred to such fund by the 10th of each month, rather than being deposited into the State General Fund. The bill would take effect upon publication in statute.

The Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks indicates that enactment of SB 510 would decrease revenue to the State General Fund by \$24,000 beginning in FY 2027, and that the interest earnings would be deposited into the Parks Fee Fund. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 510 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.
