SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 533 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 533 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Current law provides that no person holding any state or local office would be eligible to hold the Office of County Commissioner in any county in the state. SB 533 would specify that a person holding an elected state or local office would not be eligible to hold the Office in the same county. The bill would also make technical corrections.

The Secretary of the State indicates that it would use existing resources to provide training and update manuals for county election officials; update the agency's website; and update public documents and information. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 533 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.

The Kansas Association of Counties states SB 533 would not have a fiscal effect on counties.
