

**HOUSE BILL No. 2382**

1 AN ACT concerning the state board of education; increasing compensation  
2 of members of the board; establishing a daily rate of compensation that  
3 corresponds to the daily rate of compensation for services rendered by  
4 members of the legislature while in session; amending K.S.A. 72-253  
5 and repealing the existing section.

7 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

8 Section 1. K.S.A. 72-253 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-  
9 253. (a) The state board of education may authorize members thereof to  
10 attend in-state meetings for participation in matters of educational interest  
11 to the state of Kansas, and when attending a meeting so authorized,  
12 members shall receive ~~compensation~~ and travel expenses and subsistence  
13 expenses or allowances as provided in K.S.A. 75-3212 for members of the  
14 legislature. Whenever under any provision of law, a member of the state  
15 board of education is authorized to attend an out-of-state meeting, or  
16 whenever the state board of education authorizes one of its members to  
17 attend an out-of-state meeting for participation in matters of educational  
18 interest to the state of Kansas such members, when attending a meeting so  
19 authorized, shall receive ~~compensation~~ and travel expenses and  
20 subsistence expenses as provided in K.S.A. 75-3212 for members of the  
21 legislature.

22 (b) *Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 46-137a and 75-3212,*  
23 *and amendments thereto, when attending any such in-state or out-of-state*  
24 *meeting authorized in accordance with subsection (a), members of the*  
25 *state board of education shall receive compensation in an amount that*  
26 *corresponds to the daily rate of compensation for services rendered by*  
27 *members of the legislature while in session. For purposes of this section,*  
28 *such daily rate of compensation for members of the state board shall be*  
29 *determined as follows:*

30 (1) *Determine the base annual salary of members of the legislature*  
31 *established by the legislative compensation commission pursuant to K.S.A.*  
32 *46-3102, and amendments thereto, including any salary indexing*  
33 *adjustments made to such base annual salary, and multiply such amount*  
34 *by 0.6003; and*

35 (2) *divide the amount determined pursuant to paragraph (1) by 90.*

1       Sec. 2.   K.S.A. 72-253 is hereby repealed.

2       Sec. 3.   This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
3   publication in the statute book.
