AN ACT concerning the state board of education; increasing compensation
of members of the board; establishing a daily rate of compensation that
corresponds to the daily rate of compensation for services rendered by
members of the legislature while in session; amending K.S.A. 72-253
and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

8 K.S.A. 72-253 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-Section 1. 9 253. (a) The state board of education may authorize members thereof to attend in-state meetings for participation in matters of educational interest 10 to the state of Kansas, and when attending a meeting so authorized, 11 members shall receive-compensation and travel expenses and subsistence 12 expenses or allowances as provided in K.S.A. 75-3212, and amendments 13 14 thereto, for members of the legislature. Whenever under any provision of 15 law, a member of the state board of education is authorized to attend an 16 out-of-state meeting, or whenever the state board of education authorizes 17 one of its members to attend an out-of-state meeting for participation in 18 matters of educational interest to the state of Kansas such members, when 19 attending a meeting so authorized, shall receive-compensation and travel 20 expenses and or subsistence expenses as provided in K.S.A. 75-3212, and 21 amendments thereto, for members of the legislature.

22 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 46-137a and 75-3212, and amendments thereto, when attending any such in-state or out-of-state 23 24 meeting authorized in accordance with subsection (a), members of the-25 state board of education shall receive compensation in an amount thatcorresponds to the daily rate of compensation for services rendered by-26 members of the legislature while in session. For purposes of this section, 27 such daily rate of compensation for members of the state board shall be-28 29 determined as follows: 30 (1) Determine the base annual salary of members of the legislature. 31 established by the legislative compensation commission pursuant to K.S.A.

32 46-3102, and amendments thereto, including any salary indexing-

33 adjustments made to such base annual salary, and multiply such amount.

2 (2) divide the amount determined pursuant to paragraph (1) by 90
3 during any fiscal year, each member of the board of education shall
4 receive the following amount of compensation:

5 (1) For regularly scheduled meetings of the board of education 6 held pursuant to K.S.A. 72-249, and amendments thereto, \$286.81 per 7 calendar day for the member's service at any such regularly scheduled 8 meeting; and

9 (2) for attendance at any other in-state meeting for participation 10 in matters of educational interest to the state of Kansas, \$286.81 per 11 calendar day for the member's service for the first 12 calendar days 12 and \$172 per calendar day for the member's service for any additional 13 days beyond such 12 calendar days.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 72-253 is hereby repealed.
