1 AN ACT concerning adult care homes; relating to the adult care home
2 licensure act; amending the definition of home plus to increase the cap
3 of residents from 12 to 16; amending K.S.A. 2025 Supp. 39-923 and
4 repealing the existing section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2025 Supp. 39-923 is hereby amended to read as
8 follows: 39-923. (a) As used in this act:

9 (1) "Adult care home" means any nursing facility, nursing facility for
10 mental health, intermediate care facility for people with intellectual
11 disability, assisted living facility, residential healthcare facility, home plus,
12 boarding care home and adult day care facility, all of which are
13 classifications of adult care homes and are required to be licensed by the
14 secretary for aging and disability services.

15 (2) "Nursing facility" means any place or facility operating 24 hours a
16 day, seven days a week, caring for six or more individuals not related
17 within the third degree of relationship to the administrator or owner by
18 blood or marriage and who, due to functional impairments, need skilled
19 nursing care to compensate for activities of daily living limitations.

20 (3) "Nursing facility for mental health" means any place or facility
21 operating 24 hours a day, seven days a week, caring for six or more
22 individuals not related within the third degree of relationship to the
23 administrator or owner by blood or marriage and who, due to functional
24 impairments, need skilled nursing care and special mental health services
25 to compensate for activities of daily living limitations.

26 (4) "Intermediate care facility for people with intellectual disability"
27 means any place or facility operating 24 hours a day, seven days a week,
28 caring for four or more individuals not related within the third degree of
29 relationship to the administrator or owner by blood or marriage and who,
30 due to functional impairments caused by intellectual disability or related
31 conditions, need services to compensate for activities of daily living
32 limitations.

33 (5) "Assisted living facility" means any place or facility caring for six
34 or more individuals not related within the third degree of relationship to
35 the administrator, operator or owner by blood or marriage and who, by

1 choice or due to functional impairments, may need personal care and
2 supervised nursing care to compensate for activities of daily living
3 limitations and in which the place or facility includes apartments for
4 residents and provides or coordinates a range of services, including
5 personal care or supervised nursing care *that is* available 24 hours a day,
6 seven days a week, for the support of resident independence. The
7 provision of skilled nursing procedures to a resident in an assisted living
8 facility is not prohibited by this act. Generally, the skilled services
9 provided in an assisted living facility shall be provided on an intermittent
10 or limited term basis, or if limited in scope, a regular basis.

11 (6) "Residential healthcare facility" means any place or facility, or a
12 contiguous portion of a place or facility, caring for six or more individuals
13 not related within the third degree of relationship to the administrator,
14 operator or owner by blood or marriage and who, by choice or due to
15 functional impairments, may need personal care and supervised nursing
16 care to compensate for activities of daily living limitations and ~~where~~ such
17 place or facility includes individual living units and provides or
18 coordinates personal care or supervised nursing care *that is* available 24
19 hours a day, seven days a week, for the support of resident independence.
20 The provision of skilled nursing procedures to a resident in a residential
21 healthcare facility is not prohibited by this act. Generally, the skilled
22 services provided in a residential healthcare facility shall be provided on
23 an intermittent or limited term basis, or if limited in scope, a regular basis.

24 (7) "Home plus" means any residence or facility caring for not more
25 than ~~12~~ 16 individuals not related within the third degree of relationship to
26 the operator or owner by blood or marriage unless the resident in need of
27 care is approved for placement by the secretary for children and families,
28 and ~~who~~ *such resident*, due to functional impairment, needs personal care
29 and may need supervised nursing care to compensate for activities of daily
30 living limitations. The level of care provided to residents shall be
31 determined by preparation of the staff and rules and regulations developed
32 by the Kansas department for aging and disability services. An adult care
33 home may convert a portion of one wing of the facility to a ~~not less~~ *fewer*
34 than five-bed but not more than ~~12-bed~~ 16-bed home plus facility if the
35 home plus facility remains separate from the adult care home and each
36 facility remains contiguous. Any home plus that provides care for more
37 than eight individuals after the effective date of this act shall adjust
38 staffing personnel and resources as necessary to meet residents' needs in
39 order to maintain the current level of nursing care standards. **Any home**
40 **plus that provides care for more than 12 individuals on and after July**
41 **1, 2026, shall develop and maintain written plans demonstrating the**
42 **ability of such home plus to meet residents' needs, respond to**
43 **emergencies and maintain resident health and safety at the increased**

1 **capacity. Such plans shall be available for review during survey or**
2 **inspection to ensure that the home plus has the capacity to safely serve**
3 **additional residents without diminishing the quality of care.** Personnel
4 of any home plus who provide services for residents with dementia shall
5 be required to take annual dementia care training.

6 (8) "Boarding care home" means any place or facility operating 24
7 hours a day, seven days a week, caring for not more than 10 individuals
8 not related within the third degree of relationship to the operator or owner
9 by blood or marriage and who, due to functional impairment, need
10 supervision of activities of daily living but who are ambulatory and
11 essentially capable of managing their own care and affairs.

12 (9) "Continuing care retirement community" means any place or
13 facility that combines a range of housing and services to encompass the
14 continuum of aging care needs provided at an independent living facility,
15 an assisted living facility, a residential healthcare facility, home plus or a
16 skilled nursing care facility within a single place or facility to avoid the
17 need for residents to relocate to a separate place or facility. The provision
18 of community care includes the multiple levels of care provided as part of
19 a continuing care retirement community.

20 (10) "Adult day care" means any place or facility operating less than
21 24 hours a day caring for individuals not related within the third degree of
22 relationship to the operator or owner by blood or marriage and who, due to
23 functional impairment, need supervision of or assistance with activities of
24 daily living.

25 (11) "Place or facility" means a building—or, any one or more
26 complete floors of a building,—or any one or more complete wings of a
27 building; or any one or more complete wings and one or more complete
28 floors of a building. "Place or facility" includes multiple buildings.

29 (12) "Skilled nursing care" means services performed by or under the
30 immediate supervision of a registered professional nurse and additional
31 licensed nursing personnel. Skilled nursing includes administration of
32 medications and treatments as prescribed by a licensed physician or dentist
33 and other nursing functions that require substantial nursing judgment and
34 skill based on the knowledge and application of scientific principles.

35 (13) "Supervised nursing care" means services provided by or under
36 the guidance of a licensed nurse with initial direction for nursing
37 procedures and periodic inspection of the actual act of accomplishing the
38 procedures, administration of medications and treatments as prescribed by
39 a licensed physician or dentist and assistance of residents with the
40 performance of activities of daily living.

41 (14) "Resident" means all individuals kept, cared for, treated, boarded
42 or otherwise accommodated in any adult care home.

43 (15) "Person" means any individual, firm, partnership, corporation,

1 company, association or joint-stock association, and the legal successor
2 thereof.

3 (16) "Operate an adult care home" means to own, lease, sublease,
4 establish, maintain, conduct the affairs of or manage an adult care home,
5 except that for the purposes of this definition the words "own" and "lease"
6 do not include hospital districts, cities and counties that hold title to an
7 adult care home purchased or constructed through the sale of bonds.

8 (17) "Licensing agency" means the secretary for aging and disability
9 services.

10 (18) "Skilled nursing home" means a nursing facility.

11 (19) "Intermediate nursing care home" means a nursing facility.

12 (20) "Apartment" means a private unit that includes, but is not limited
13 to, a toilet room with bathing facilities, a kitchen, sleeping, living and
14 storage area and a lockable door.

15 (21) "Individual living unit" means a private unit that includes, but is
16 not limited to, a toilet room with bathing facilities, sleeping, living and
17 storage area and a lockable door.

18 (22) "Operator" means an individual registered pursuant to the
19 operator registration act, K.S.A. 39-973 et seq., and amendments thereto,
20 who may be appointed by a licensee to have the authority and
21 responsibility to oversee an assisted living facility or residential healthcare
22 facility with fewer than 61 residents, a home plus or adult day care facility.

23 (23) "Activities of daily living" means those personal, functional
24 activities required by an individual for continued well-being, including,
25 but not limited to, eating, nutrition, dressing, personal hygiene, mobility
26 and toileting.

27 (24) "Personal care" means care provided by staff to assist an
28 individual with or to perform activities of daily living.

29 (25) "Functional impairment" means an individual has experienced a
30 decline in physical, mental and psychosocial well-being and, as a result, is
31 unable to compensate for the effects of the decline.

32 (26) "Kitchen" means a food preparation area that includes a sink,
33 refrigerator and a microwave oven or stove.

34 (27) "Intermediate personal care home" means a residential
35 healthcare facility for purposes of those individuals applying for or
36 receiving veterans' benefits means residential healthcare facility.

37 (28) "Paid nutrition assistant" means an individual who is paid to feed
38 residents of an adult care home, or who is used under an arrangement with
39 another agency or organization, who is trained by a person meeting nurse
40 aide instructor qualifications as prescribed by 42 C.F.R. § 483.152, 42
41 C.F.R. § 483.160 and 42 C.F.R. § 483.35(h); and who provides such
42 assistance under the supervision of a registered professional or licensed
43 practical nurse.

1 (29) "Medicaid program" means the Kansas program of medical
2 assistance for which federal or state moneys, or any combination thereof,
3 are expended *or* any successor federal or state, or both, health insurance
4 program or waiver granted thereunder.

5 (30) "Licensee" means any person or persons acting jointly or
6 severally who are licensed by the secretary for aging and disability
7 services pursuant to the adult care home licensure act, K.S.A. 39-923 et
8 seq., and amendments thereto.

9 (31) "Insolvent" means that the adult care home or any individual or
10 entity that operates an adult care home or appears on the adult care home
11 license ~~and~~ has stopped paying debts in the ordinary course of business or
12 is unable to pay debts as they come due in the ordinary course of business.

13 (b) "Adult care home" does not include institutions operated by
14 federal or state governments, except institutions operated by the director of
15 the Kansas office of veterans services, hospitals or institutions for the
16 treatment and care of psychiatric patients, child care facilities, maternity
17 centers, hotels, offices of physicians or hospices that are certified to
18 participate in the medicare program under 42 C.F.R. § 418.1 et seq.; and
19 provide services only to hospice patients, or centers approved by the
20 centers for medicare and medicaid services as a program for all-inclusive
21 care for the elderly (PACE) under 42 C.F.R. § 460 et seq.; that provides
22 services only to PACE participants.

23 (c) Nursing facilities in existence on the effective date of this act
24 changing licensure categories to become residential healthcare facilities
25 shall be required to provide private bathing facilities in a minimum of 20%
26 of the individual living units.

27 (d) Facilities licensed under the adult care home licensure act on the
28 day immediately preceding the effective date of this act shall continue to
29 be licensed facilities until the annual renewal date of such license and may
30 renew such license in the appropriate licensure category under the adult
31 care home licensure act subject to the payment of fees and other conditions
32 and limitations of such act.

33 (e) Nursing facilities with fewer than 60 beds converting a portion of
34 the facility to residential healthcare shall have the option of licensing for
35 residential healthcare for fewer than six individuals but not less than 10%
36 of the total bed count within a contiguous portion of the facility.

37 (f) The licensing agency may by rule and regulation change the name
38 of the different classes of homes when necessary to avoid confusion in
39 terminology, and such agency may further amend, substitute, change and,
40 in a manner consistent with the definitions established in this section,
41 further define and identify the specific acts and services that shall fall
42 within the respective categories of facilities—*so long as if* the above
43 categories for adult care homes are used as guidelines to define and
