1 AN ACT concerning crimes, punishment and criminal procedure; relating  
2 to sexual extortion; requiring the attorney general to prepare and  
3 provide educational materials and information concerning such crime;  
4 increasing the penalties for such crime when an offender is 18 years of  
5 age or older and the victim is less than 18 years of age or a dependent  
6 adult; creating the crimes of aggravated sexual extortion causing great  
7 bodily harm and aggravated sexual extortion causing death; amending  
8 K.S.A. 21-5515 and repealing the existing section.

10 **{WHEREAS, Section 1 and the amendments made to the**  
11 **provisions of K.S.A. 21-5515 by this act shall be known as Caleb's**  
12 **Law.}**

13 **{Now, therefore:}**

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

15 New Section 1. The attorney general shall prepare and provide  
16 educational materials and information concerning sexual extortion as  
17 defined in K.S.A. 21-5515, and amendments thereto. The attorney general  
18 shall collaborate with the state board of education and law enforcement  
19 agencies to educate and notify schools, students, parents and guardians and  
20 the public about the amendments to K.S.A. 21-5515, and amendments  
21 thereto, by this act and the availability of educational materials and  
22 information concerning sexual extortion. On or before July 1, 2027, and  
23 annually thereafter, the attorney general shall file a report regarding the  
24 implementation of this section with the governor, the president and  
25 minority leader of the senate, the speaker and minority leader of the house  
26 of representatives and the state board of education.

27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 21-5515 is hereby amended to read as follows: 21-  
28 5515. (a) Sexual extortion is:

29 (1) Communicating by any means ~~a demand for anything of value or~~  
30 a threat to injure the property or reputation of a person, commit violence  
31 against a person; or distribute an image, video or other recording of a  
32 person that is of a sexual nature or depicts ~~such~~ a person in a state of  
33 nudity:

2       ~~(A)(i)~~ Engage in sexual contact, sexual intercourse or conduct that is

30       (b) Aggravated sexual extortion causing great bodily harm is sexual  
31 extortion as defined in subsection (a) resulting in great bodily harm to the  
32 victim and the trier of fact finds that the sexual extortion of the victim was  
33 the proximate cause of the great bodily harm.

34       (c) Aggravated sexual extortion causing death is sexual extortion as  
35 defined in subsection (a) resulting in the death of the victim and the trier  
36 of fact finds that the sexual extortion of the victim was the proximate cause  
37 of the death.

38       (d) Sexual extortion as defined in:

39       (1) Subsection (a)(1)(A) or (a)(2)(A) is a:

40       (A) Severity level 7, person felony, except as provided in subsection  
41 (d)(1)(B); and

42       (B) severity level 6, person felony when the offender is 18 years of  
43 age or older and the victim is:

- 1       (i) *Less than 18 years of age; or*  
2       (ii) *a dependent adult; and*  
3       (2) ~~subsection (a)(2)~~ *(a)(1)(B) or (a)(2)(B) is a:*  
4       (A) *Severity level 4, person felony, except as provided in subsection*  
5 *(d)(2)(B); and*  
6       (B) *a severity level 3, person felony when the offender is 18 years of*  
7 *age or older and the victim is:*  
8       (i) *Less than 18 years of age; or*  
9       (ii) *a dependent adult.*  
10      ~~(e)~~(e) *Aggravated sexual extortion causing great bodily harm is a*  
11 *severity level 3, person felony.*  
12      (f) *Aggravated sexual extortion causing death is a severity level 1,*  
13 *person felony.*  
14      (g) *It shall not be a defense that the victim contributed to the victim's*  
15 *own great bodily harm or death.*  
16      (h) *As used in this section:*  
17       (1) *"Dependent adult" means the same as defined in K.S.A. 21-5417,*  
18 *and amendments thereto; and*  
19       (2) ~~"image, video or other recording" includes any image, video or~~  
20 ~~other recording~~ **means any photograph, film, video picture, digital or**  
21 **computer-generated image or picture, whether made or produced by**  
22 **electronic, mechanical or other means, including, but not limited to,**  
23 **any such item that has been created, in whole or in part, altered or**  
24 **modified by artificial intelligence or any digital means to appear to depict**  
25 **or purport to depict a person, regardless of whether such person was**  
26 **involved in the creation of the original image, video or other recording.**  
27       (i) *This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the Kansas*  
28 *criminal code.*  
29      Sec. 3. K.S.A. 21-5515 is hereby repealed.  
30      Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
31 publication in the statute book.
