

## HOUSE BILL No. 2543

1 AN ACT concerning wildlife and parks; requiring an annual  
2 reimbursement to the Kansas department of wildlife and parks for lost  
3 revenue from free or discounted hunting and fishing licenses, permits  
4 or passes that were established by legislative enactment on or after July  
5 1, 2027; requiring the department to maintain an accounting of lost  
6 revenue and submit such accounting to the director of accounts and  
7 reports and the state treasurer by June 30 of each fiscal year; requiring  
8 that such accounting be subject to audits by the state treasurer; making  
9 an annual transfer from the state general fund to the wildlife fee fund  
10 upon certification of such accounting, subject to appropriation acts of  
11 the legislature.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. (a) (1) The Kansas department of wildlife and parks shall  
15 be reimbursed for lost revenue resulting from the issuance of any free or  
16 partially discounted hunting and fishing license, permit or pass that was  
17 established by legislative enactment on or after July 1, 2027, in an amount  
18 equal to the amount of lost revenue from such discounts.

19 (2) This section shall also apply to lost revenue resulting from any  
20 exemption to hunting and fishing license, permit or pass that was  
21 established by statute on or after July 1, 2027, in an amount equal to the  
22 amount of lost revenue from such exemptions.

23 (b) (1) The department shall maintain an accounting of such lost  
24 revenue and certify and submit such accounting to the director of accounts  
25 and reports and the state treasurer on or before June 30 of each fiscal year  
26 for the reimbursement of such lost revenue from the state general fund.

27 (2) Such accounting and any other records relating to the accounting  
28 shall be subject to audit by the state treasurer.

29 (c) Upon receipt of certification of such accounting, or as soon  
30 thereafter as moneys are available, and subject to appropriation acts of the  
31 legislature, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer an amount  
32 equal to such accounting from the state general fund to the wildlife fee  
33 fund of the Kansas department of wildlife and parks. Each time that the  
34 department transmits such certification to the director of accounts and  
35 reports and the state treasurer, the department shall transmit a copy to the  
36 director of the budget and the director of legislative research.

1       Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
2       publication in the statute book.
