

## HOUSE BILL No. 2555

1 AN ACT concerning rural health; requiring grant applications, expenditure  
2 information, reports and other documentation concerning the rural  
3 health transformation program to be presented and provided to the state  
4 finance council, house of representatives committee on appropriations,  
5 senate committee on ways and means and legislative budget committee.

7 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

8 Section 1. (a) All grant applications from a partner, stakeholder or  
9 subawardee requesting moneys from the rural health transformation  
10 program established pursuant to section 71401 of public law 119-21,  
11 following review of such application by the Kansas rural health innovation  
12 alliance, shall be presented to the state finance council at a state finance  
13 council meeting.

14 (b) As soon as practicable following the expenditure, information  
15 concerning the moneys expended by the state of Kansas from the centers  
16 for medicare and medicaid services pursuant to section 71401 of public  
17 law 119-21 for the rural health transformation program and any other  
18 federal law that appropriates moneys to the state for the rural health  
19 transformation program shall be presented to the state finance council at a  
20 state finance council meeting.

21 (c) Any report and other documentation required to be submitted to  
22 the centers for medicare and medicaid services pursuant to section 71401  
23 of public law 119-21 shall be provided to the state finance council.

24 (d) All grant applications, expenditure information, reports and other  
25 documentation required to be presented and provided pursuant to this  
26 section shall also be presented and provided to the house of representatives  
27 committee on appropriations and the senate committee on ways and means  
28 at a committee meeting during the regular session of the legislature and to  
29 the legislative budget committee when the legislature is not in regular  
30 session.

31 (e) The governor shall designate who will present and provide the  
32 information as required by this section.

33 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
34 publication in the Kansas register.
