1 AN ACT concerning the department of wildlife and parks; relating to fees;  
2 increasing the service charge fee for each license, permit, stamp or  
3 other issue of the department of wildlife and parks to an amount of not  
4 to exceed \$2.00 and, in the case of each migratory waterfowl habitat  
5 stamp, an amount of not to exceed \$1.00; amending K.S.A. 32-989 and  
6 repealing the existing section.

8 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

9 Section 1. K.S.A. 32-989 is hereby amended to read as follows: 32-  
10 989. (a) In addition to the fees prescribed pursuant to law or rules and  
11 regulations of the secretary, the secretary shall, and the county clerk and  
12 any agent appointed pursuant to K.S.A. 32-985, and amendments thereto,  
13 may, charge and retain a service charge fee *of not to exceed \$1.00 \$2.00*  
14 **plus an additional fee of not to exceed what is necessary to recover the**  
15 **actual amount of any cost incurred by reason of the method of**  
16 **payment used by the payee** for each license, permit, stamp or other issue  
17 of the department issued or sold by such secretary, county clerk or agent,  
18 except:

19 (1) *When**If* such service charge fee is otherwise established by law,  
20 the amount charged shall be the amount otherwise established;

21 (2) for licenses, permits, stamps or other issues sold by an approved  
22 telephone agent or over the internet by an approved internet agent, for  
23 which the agent may charge and receive a service fee charge negotiated by  
24 the secretary and the agent, in addition to the actual cost remitted to the  
25 department of the licenses, permits, stamps or other issues sold during a  
26 telephone or internet transaction other than the service charge per issue  
27 and the negotiated service charge fee;

28 (3) in the case of a migratory waterfowl habitat stamp, the service  
29 charge fee shall not exceed *\$.50 \$1.00* **plus an additional fee of not to**  
30 **exceed what is necessary to recover the actual amount of any cost**  
31 **incurred by reason of the method of payment used by the payee;** and

32 (4) the secretary shall not charge service charge fees for issues of the  
33 department issued or sold to a person appointed by the secretary pursuant  
34 to K.S.A. 32-985, and amendments thereto, to sell such issues.

35 (b) Any moneys collected by the secretary for fees imposed pursuant

1 to this section shall be disposed of as provided by K.S.A. 32-990, 32-991  
2 and 32-993, and amendments thereto. Any such moneys collected by the  
3 county clerk shall be deposited in the county general fund.

4 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 32-989 is hereby repealed.

5 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
6 publication in the statute book.
