1 AN ACT concerning the state capitol; relating to permanent displays;
2 directing the capitol preservation committee to develop and approve
3 plans for a registry kiosk of Kansas military forces killed in action or
4 who died of wounds incurred during active duty to be placed within the
5 state capitol.

7 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

8 Section 1. (a) The capitol preservation committee shall approve plans
9 to place a permanent registry kiosk within the state capitol of Kansas
10 military forces killed in action or who died of wounds incurred during
11 active duty pursuant to K.S.A. 75-2269, and amendments thereto.

12 (b) The secretary of administration is hereby authorized to receive
13 moneys from any grants, gifts, contributions or bequests made for the
14 purpose of financing the creation and construction of the registry kiosk and
15 to expend such moneys received for such purpose. The secretary of
16 administration shall remit all moneys so received to the state treasurer in
17 accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments
18 thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall
19 deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the Kansas
20 military forces registry kiosk fund. No public funds shall be expended for
21 the purpose of financing the creation or construction of the registry kiosk.

22 (c) There is hereby established in the state treasury the Kansas
23 military forces registry kiosk fund. Expenditures from the fund may be
24 made for the purposes of creating and constructing the registry kiosk and
25 for such other purposes as may be specified with regard to any grant, gift,
26 contribution or bequest. All such expenditures shall be made upon
27 warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to
28 vouchers approved by the secretary of administration or the secretary's
29 designee.

30 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
31 publication in the statute book.
