1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION providing for the adjournment of the
2	house of representatives and the senate.

4	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas, the
5	Senate concurring therein: That the legislature shall adjourn at the
6	close of business of the daily session convened on March 27, 2025,
7	and shall reconvene on April 10, 2025; and
8	Be it further resolved: That the legislature may adjourn and reconvene at
9	any time during the period on and after April 10, 2025, through April
10	12, 2025, but that the legislature shall reconvene on April 12, 2025,
11	and adjourn sine die at the close of business of the daily session
12	convened on such day; and
13	Be it further resolved: That the chief clerk of the house of representatives
14	and the secretary of the senate and employees specified by the director
15	of legislative administrative services for such purpose shall attend to
16	their duties each day during periods of adjournment, Sundays
17	excepted, for the purpose of receiving messages from the governor
18	and conducting such other business as may be required; and
19	Be it further resolved: Except as otherwise provided, that members of the
20	legislature shall not receive subsistence allowances provided for in $V \le A + A \le 127 \text{ (b)}$ and ensuring the state of
21	K.S.A. 46-137a(b), and amendments thereto, for any day within a
22 23	period in which both houses of the legislature are adjourned for more
23 24	than two days, Sundays excepted; and Be it further resolved: That members of the legislature attending a
24 25	legislative meeting of whatever nature when authorized pursuant to
23 26	law or authorized by the legislative coordinating council, the president
20	of the senate or the speaker of the house of representatives and
28	members of a conference committee attending a meeting of the
29	conference committee authorized by the president of the senate and
30	the speaker of the house of representatives and members of a select
31	committee attending a meeting of the select committee authorized by
32	the president of the senate or the speaker of the house of
33	representatives during any period of adjournment shall receive travel
34	expenses and subsistence allowances as provided by law.
