

## House Concurrent Resolution No. 5021

A PROPOSITION to amend article 5 of the constitution of the state of Kansas by adding a new section to require voters to present photographic identification at the time of voting.

*Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Kansas, two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the House of Representatives and two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the Senate concurring therein:*

Section 1. The following proposition to amend the constitution of the state of Kansas shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the state for their approval or rejection: Article 5 of the constitution of the state of Kansas is hereby amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

**"§ 9. Qualified elector identification.** Each qualified elector shall present photographic identification issued by the state of Kansas or the government of the United States at the time of voting in any election. The implementation and administration of this requirement shall be prescribed by law."

Sec. 2. The following statement shall be printed on the ballot with the amendment as a whole:

*"Explanatory statement.* This amendment would require voters to present photographic identification issued by the state of Kansas or the government of the United States in order to vote in an election in Kansas.

"A vote for this proposition would require voters to present photographic identification issued by the state of Kansas or the government of the United States in order to vote in an election in Kansas."

"A vote against this proposition would make no change to the constitution of the state of Kansas, and the voter identification requirement would remain in state law only."

Sec. 3. This resolution, if approved by two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the House of Representatives and two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the Senate, shall be entered on the journals, together with the yeas and nays. The secretary of state shall cause this resolution to be published as provided by law and shall cause the proposed amendment to be submitted

1 to the electors of the state at a special election, which is hereby called on  
2 August 4, 2026, pursuant to section 1 of article 14 of the constitution of  
3 the state of Kansas, to be held in conjunction with the primary election  
4 held on such date.
