1 AN ACT concerning state officers; requiring the office of each state officer
2 to keep and maintain records of information concerning all travel
3 locations and expenses of the state officer that were paid or reimbursed
4 by the state during each fiscal year and provide such records of
5 information upon request by a member of the public.

7 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

8 Section 1. (a) For purposes of this section, "state officer" means the
9 governor, lieutenant governor, attorney general, secretary of state, state
10 treasurer and commissioner of insurance.

11 (b) Each office of a state officer shall keep and maintain a full and
12 complete record of information concerning all travel locations and
13 expenses of each such state officer that were paid or reimbursed by the
14 state during each fiscal year. Each such office shall provide such records of
15 information relating to the travel locations and expenses of the state officer
16 upon request by a member of the public.

17 (c) The provisions of K.S.A. 45-221, and amendments thereto, or any
18 other state law that limits the disclosure of records of state officers, shall
19 not apply to the records of information required to be kept and maintained
20 by subsection (b).

21 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
22 publication in the statute book.
