

SENATE RESOLUTION No. 1733

A RESOLUTION recognizing the members of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., for their outstanding service to the citizens of our state, our nation and the international community and their promotion of sisterhood, scholarship and service.

WHEREAS, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., is a private, not-for-profit organization whose purpose is to provide assistance and support in local communities throughout the world in diverse fields related to public service through the organization's Five-Point Programmatic Thrust: Economic development, educational development, international awareness and involvement, physical and mental health and political awareness and involvement; and

WHEREAS, On January 13, 1913, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., was founded at Howard University in the District of Columbia by 22 collegiate women: Osceola Macarthy Adams, Marguerite Young Alexander, Winona Cargile Alexander, Ethel Cuff Black, Bertha Pitts Campbell, Zephyr Chisom Carter, Edna Brown Coleman, Jessie McGuire Dent, Frederica Chase Dodd, Myra Davis Hemmings, Olive C. Jones, Jimmie Bugg Middleton, Pauline Oberdorfer Minor, Vashti Turley Murphy, Naomi Sewell Richardson, Mamie Reddy Rose, Eliza Pearl Shippen, Florence Letcher Toms, Ethel Carr Watson, Wertie Blackwell Weaver, Madree Penn White and Edith Motte Young; and

WHEREAS, On March 3, 1913, the founders of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., participated in the Woman Suffrage Procession in the District of Columbia, which was the sorority's first public service act; and

WHEREAS, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., has eight chapters in Kansas and a total of 1,000 collegiate and alumnae chapters in the United States, Canada, Japan, Germany, the Virgin Islands, Bermuda, the Bahamas, Jamaica, West Africa and the Republic of Korea, with more than 350,000 members since its founding; Now, therefore,
