**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2758**

As Recommended by House Committee on  
Veterans and Military

**Brief\***

HB 2758 would require the Capitol Preservation Committee to approve plans for a permanent registry kiosk to be placed within the State Capitol of Kansas of military forces killed in action or who died of wounds incurred during active duty.

The bill would create the Kansas Military Forces Registry Kiosk Fund which would be funded by private grants, gifts, contributions, or bequests made for the purpose of financing the creation and construction of the kiosk. No public funds would be expended for the purpose of financing the creation or construction of the kiosk.

**Background**

The bill was introduced by the House Committee on Veterans and Military at the request of Representative Weigel.

***House Committee on Veterans and Military***

In the House committee hearing, **proponent** testimony was provided by Representative Weigel. The proponent generally stated this bill was a companion bill to the enacted Gold Star Families Capitol Memorial bill (2022 SB 330) and

that this kiosk would bring recognition to those who lost their lives serving in the U.S. military.
