## <u>SB 501</u>–Establishment of the Kansas Tourism Corporation <u>HB 2827</u>–Rules and regulations; consideration of effect on small employers

Chairperson Jordan announced to the Committee that  $\underline{SB 501}$  was going to have to be put into  $\underline{HB 2827}$  and that an amendment was needed to add a new section to the bill stating the sales taxes to the Tourism Corporation would be exclusive from the sales tax for STAR bonds.

Senator Brownlee made a motion to amend SB 501 adding a new section stating the sales taxes to the Tourism Corporation would be exclusive from the sales tax for STAR bonds, to "gut and go" HB 2827 and put SB 501 as amended into the Senate Substitute for HB 2827.
