Please STRIKE the following lines from SB 302 or delete the whole bill.

Page 2 line 6 (d) The secretary may prescribe rules and regulations for the

7 implementation of this section.

Page 8 line 41 (c) *The secretary may prescribe rules and regulations for the*

42 *implementation of this section.*

Page 12 line 4 Sec. 8. K.S.A. 65-6a41 is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 *maintained for a period of time as the secretary may prescribe by rules (strike)*

15 *and regulations.*

\* KSA 65-6a30d" the secretary shall not promulgate or enforce any such rules and regulations that are more stringent, restrictive or expansive than required by federal law or any rule and regulation adopted by the United States department of Agriculture.
