Dear Members of the Commerce Committee,

Today you are scheduled to hear testimony on HB 2515 regarding government contracting processes. The Labor-Management Council of Greater Kansas City opposes this bill.

As a nonprofit association with many member organizations based in or active in Kansas, we are particularly concerned with economic growth and value for taxpayers in the state. We oppose HB 2515 because it would retard growth and harm Kansas taxpayers, contractors and workers.

While the intent of the bill seems to be to bar project labor agreements by government entities, it can also be read to exclude all union workers and contractors from bidding on Kansas governmental projects and those which access public funds. Such a law would be extremely unfair to Kansas taxpayers, including the thousands of highly-trained Kansas craftspersons and hundreds of contractors who employ them. It would be particularly unfair to all Kansas taxpayers because it would excessively restrict government from choosing the lowest and best bids by excluding an entire category of contractors and workers who are often the most qualified available.

Contractors who are signatory to union agreements and their craft union partners provide the highest-quality training available to thousands of Kansans each year. Many construction projects simply would not be possible without this pool of highly-skilled workers and experienced contractors. These workers and contractors are vital for Kansas economic development and job creation.

We do not advocate mandating project labor agreements or the use of only union contractors on public projects. Rather we strongly support a level playing field and open, professional contracting practices by government at all levels. Allowing all responsible contractors, particularly those employing Kansas workers, to bid on public projects and allowing a variety of options for delivery of construction services including project labor agreements saves Kansas taxpayers money and enhances the quality of those projects.

Whatever the intent of HB 2515, the exclusion of qualified contractors and workers from Kansas construction projects is not only unfair to thousands of Kansas workers but a blow to the interests of all Kansas taxpayers.
