Representative Sloan,

The State motor fuel tax rate is \$.24/gallon for gasoline and \$.26/gallon for diesel fuel. There is no tax charged for CNG.

I have read that the EPA has produced a formula in which 33.7 kilowatt hours of electricity is equivalent to one gallon of gasoline.
