Renaë,

The committee asked a few questions that I did not know the answers for this morning, and the following information has been provided to address those questions.

Under article 34 – Motor Vehicle Fuel Taxes, we do charge a \$.23 tax on LP-gas, defined as follows in KSA 79-3490 (b)

"LP-gas" means liquefied gasses, including liquefied natural gas and compressed natural gas, composed predominantly of the hydrocarbons which exist in the gaseous state at a temperature of 60° Fahrenheit and at a pressure of 14.7 pounds per square inch absolute and which may be used for the purpose of operating or propelling motor vehicles upon the public roads, state highways, streets or alleys.
