





Testimony to the House Judiciary Committee In Support of HB2470: Scrap Metal Dealers February 2, 2012

Chairman Kinzer and Committee Members,

This bill was drafted as a trailer bill to HB2312 passed last year. During the conference committee process we continued to work with the scrap metal dealers to address their remaining concerns. During that process we agreed to delete certain language. However, one of the strikeouts did not get removed in the actual conference committee report. During the interim we continued to attempt to address this with the scrap metal dealers. During these conversations we agreed to support a bill in the 2012 session to strike the language we had previously agreed to remove from HB2312. That amendment to the existing statute is located on page 2, lines 20 and 21 of HB2470.

Subsequent to the introduction of this bill, the Attorney General issued an opinion number 2012-4 on January 24, 2012. The opinion was in response to a request from John Gatz, city attorney for the city of Colby. In that opinion the Attorney General opines that the language in HB2312 will require a renewal fee in the amount of the initial fee, which is set between \$100 and \$400, plus the renewal fee, which is set between \$25 and \$50. Clearly that was not the intent. We therefore respectfully request an additional amendment to strike the following from 2011 Session Law Chapter 86 §1, subsection (g): ", which shall be in addition to the fee provided by subsection (e)," We believe a balloon has already been drafted to make that amendment to the bill.

We respectfully ask you to approve the amendment and recommend the amended bill favorably for passage.
