Dear Senator Umbarger:

The Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism (KDWPT) appreciates the opportunity to discuss with the committee the Departments five year Capital Improvement Plan and 2014 Capital Improvements. Attached are two tables with the Five year Capital improvement Plan, and the 2014 Capital improvement request.

The Five year plan is divided into two parts: New construction and additions, and rehabilitation and repair of current assets. New construction and additions will consist of Land Acquisition, Cabin Site Preparation, Trails Development, Shooting Range Development, River Access, Wetlands Acquisition and Development, Federal Boating Access, State and Federal Ag Funds, and Land and Water Conservation Development. Rehabilitation and Repair will consist of Parks Major Maintenance, Public Lands Major maintenance, Road Maintenance, and Bridge Maintenance. There is no State General Fund or EDIF Money scheduled to be used for capital improvements this year.

For FY 2014, the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism (KDWPT) is requesting a capital improvements budget that totals \$8,700,187. KDWPT is requesting an amount of \$500,000 from the Park Fee Fund (PFF) for Parks Major Maintenance, and \$375,000 from Land and Water conservation development fund. The need for funding to maintain the state parks is ongoing. Without adequate funds to maintain the state parks facilities, KDWPT is becoming out of compliance with KDHE for our sewer lagoons in many parks, and the electrical systems are critically out of date for today's standards.

The remaining items in the FY 2014 capital improvement request are continuing programs and include \$1,537,000 for public lands maintenance (790,000 from WFF and 747,000 from State and Federal Ag funds), \$200,000 for bridge maintenance, \$300,000 for cabin site preparation, \$650,000 for wetlands acquisition and development, \$300,000 for land acquisition,, \$1,033,000 for federally mandated boating access projects, \$400,000 for trails development, \$100,000 for river access, \$100,000 for shooting range development, and \$200,000 for bridge maintenance.

In addition to the above, KDWPT has amended the FY 2014 capital improvement budget request to include projects funded from the Department access road fund in the amount of \$3,205,187. This is an amount of \$1,505,187 above our originally requested amount of \$1,700,000. This increase was requested to take advantage of excess balances in this fund, that were held to help cover potential shortfalls in Park operations, and a lack of manpower to complete designated projects.

For FY 2014 the Department has determined that adequate funds are available to finance the following projects from the Department access road fund;
