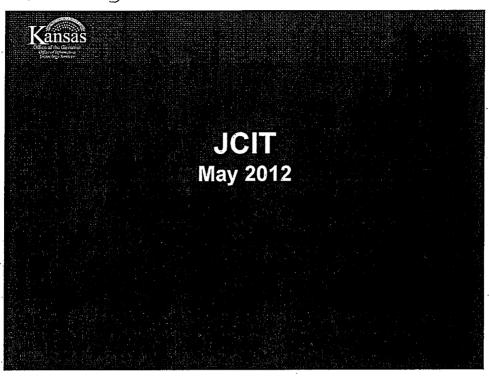
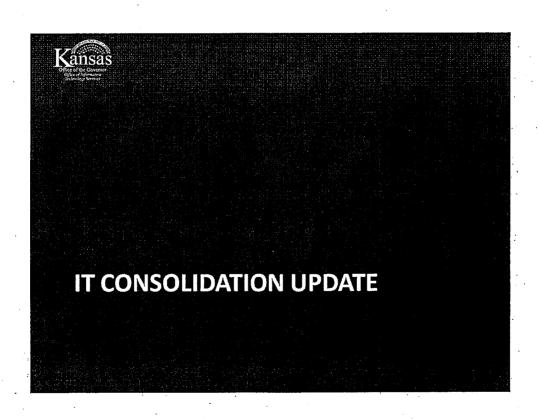

- All will require significant planning.

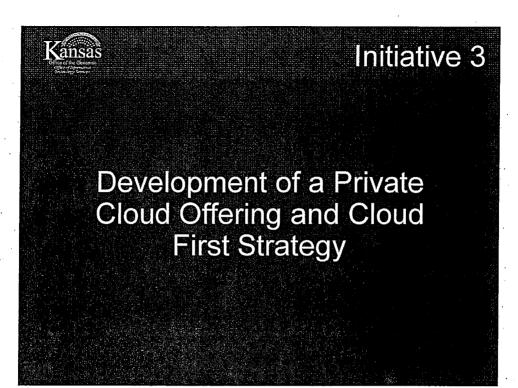


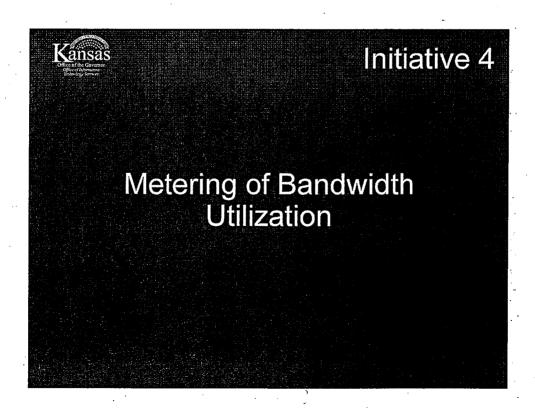

UC Video

- Planned Project for UC Video Network was submitted in Three-Year IT Management and Budget Plan
- Internal team has been performing research to understand various forms of video and how they relate to UC
 - Desktop video, video conferencing, Webx sessions, Telepresence, Digital Media, Live streaming technologies and mobile video are being explored



UC Video

- Current video solutions are deployed independently without voice integration. UC has the potential to converge these technologies together into an Enterprise UC solution
- Next step is to collaborate with agencies to determine requirements, architecture, costs and feasibility of an enterprise solution.
- No official project plan has been filed with the KITO's office

 - Monitoring and Control Manager
 - Cloud Services Manager
 - Planning and Engineering Manager
 - Two Network Engineers
 - Project Manager
